“REPEATING PISTOL” Courses on Saturday a.m. & p.m. and Sunday a.m.; MLAIC “PRECISION” and other ML courses on Sunday p.m. ----
AND Gallery Rifle and LBP and LBR courses throughout the weekend.

OVERVIEW:- “REPEATING PISTOL” Courses on Saturday a.m. & p.m. and Sunday a.m.;
MLAIC “PRECISION” and other ML courses on Sunday p.m. ---- AND Gallery Rifle and LBP and LBR courses throughout the weekend.
Unlimited re-entry with different firearms (even if only the Serial Number is different!). Pre-squadded and self-squadded;
Single Matches £5 OR you can reserve a Firing-Point for half a day (with up to 5 Courses of Fire) for £25

“Repeating Pistol” Courses are **Offhand** (one hand!) and **Supported** (Two-handed);

FIREARMS:- A wide range of percussion repeating pistols, original, reproduction or “modern design”; (plus single-shots for MLAIC Precision):
Black Powder substitutes permitted except for ORIGINAL 19thC revolvers.

STANDARD PERCUSSION REVOLVER (Class S) -- 19th Century design with no later improvements – see below*

- * Expensive Match Grade revolvers such as the Feinwerkbau and those fitted with Lothar Walther barrels, etc., are NOT permitted in this Class
- TWO Classes ---- “S1” -- one-handed and “S2” two hand hold permitted.**

PERCUSSION TARGET REVOLVER (Class T) -- target sights, grips, “tuned” & Special versions etc + Ruger OA allowed.

- ** Standard Revolvers + Match Grade revolvers, Ruger etc., eligible – **one-handed (“offhand”) hold only.**

“FREE” PERCUSSION REVOLVER (Class F) -- any sights (except laser), target grips.

- *** * Any Percussion Revolver (NOT the “Patriot” repeater); one or two-hand hold.

“MODERN M-L PISTOL” (Class M) -- ANY M-L repeating pistol including “Patriot” and Smokeless Conversions.

- *** – **TWO Classes ---- “M1” -- one-handed, and “M2” -- two hand hold permitted.**

A “simpler” type of firearm may be used in a “higher” Match but not vice-versa.

COURSES OF FIRE:-

MLAIC PRECISION (best 10 ex 13 in 30 minutes) ONLY on the Sunday Afternoon

All “REPEATING PISTOL” courses consist of optional **unlimited sighters** and **15 scored shots (3 x 5-shots series)**, fired on ONE target in the specified time-limit). Loading time will be given before each 5-shot series.

TARGETS: HBSA 25m-scaled version of the original NRA 20y target, shot at 25yards/ 25m as available: a **TEMPORARY** Aiming Mark may be used.

SLOW-FIRE:- 3 x (5 shots in 3 minutes)

TIMED-FIRE:- 3 x (5 shots in 1 minute)

RAPID-FIRE :- 3 x (5 shots in 30 seconds)

“BOBBER”:- 3 x (5 shots “Duelling”) - target “faced” for 5s, “edged” for 10s.

“SURRENDEN” :- 3 series of 5 shots Against the Clock. The TOTAL time (in whole seconds) for 3 series will be subtracted from the target score.

AWARDS

ATSC Place medals, Winner Certificates and Skilled Shot Certificates scaled according to entries (over 50% on Entrants will receive an Award).

* Special Awards within Matches will be available – e.g., Original/Repro; Open / Closed Frame; “S-A” / “D-A”

PROCEDURES:-

Normal NRA Procedures will apply. Firers must show their “Competency Certificate” (available from the Chairman of your NRA-affiliated Club)

LOADING: A loading period is allowed before each series: *loading from phials is recommended but not mandatory.*

SIGHTERS: An optional sighting series is allowed before each Course of Fire.

ONE HAND or TWO?

In an OFFHAND (one-handed support) Match – unless otherwise stated, the revolver may be cocked with the Afree@ hand but must NOT be supported by more than one hand at the instant of discharge.
