| Ammunition | Competitors are to supply their own ammunition. All users are responsible for ensuring that it is in every respect safe, within range safety parameters and complies with Range Regulations. For TR, maximum bullet weight is 155gr. |
| HME | F Class competitors using HME calibres must report at 08.30 on Saturday 20 May to conduct HME zeroing prior to the start of the competition. |
| Muzzle Breaks | Prohibited |
| Challenge Cups | All trophies must be returned by 1 st March 2018 to Northants & Leics R.A. |
| Conditions | NRA rules and regulations will apply |
| Targets | NRA match targets will be used at all distances (TR and F Class) |
| Marking | All competitors will be squadded to include Butt marking duties |
| Ties | In all competitions V-bulls will be taken into account in breaking ties. Where scores are tied in both in points and Vs a tie shoot will take place at a time to be announced. |
| Briefing | All competitors are to attend a mandatory Range and Safety Briefing at 'A' Range at the following times: Saturday 20 May at 09.30 Sunday 21 May at 09.00 |
| Under 25 | Under 25 years are eligible for the Evan Price Memorial Trophy and pay 40% discounted entry fees. Please enter your Date of Birth on the entry form and pay the reduced fee |
| Prize Giving | Prize giving will take place behind the 600 yds FP approximately 30 minutes after the final competition |

From 1st January 2009, each civilian shooting on an MoD range must carry a Shooter Certification Card (SCC) signed by the chairman of a club to which he/she is a member and which is affiliated to the NRA.
