Thorpe Cloud rifle range is situated near to Thorpe village, Dovedale, Derbyshire. Full details of the arrangements for meeting up will be advised to participants on receipt of competition entry form and payment. Please note that no unofficial cars are allowed on the range. Official transport will be provided for those requiring assistance. All others will proceed to the range on foot.

Programme:

Friday 17th June: competitors will meet for a Patched Ball shoot at 200 yards plus a spare target for practice (dependent on the number of entries for the Patched Ball event), any patched ball black powder rifle, 10 shots from a rest standing and 10 shots off hand.

Saturday 18th June: a three range Free Rifle competition at 400, 300 and 200 yards (in that order), 1 warmer, 3 sighters and 10 to count at each distance.

Saturday evening: we will gather at the "Coach & Horses", Fenny Bentley, 7.30 pm for 8 pm to partake of a meal and presentations. PLEASE NOTE- If you are attending the evening meal and presentations you must let me know by the 31st May (see the booking form).

Sunday 19th June: a three range minié competition at 200, 300 and 400yards. Enfield .577 rifles (NO SLINGS to be used) shooting at reproduction targets of the type used at the first Notts RA meeting in 1861. 1 warmer, 1 sighter and 5 to count at 200 yards, 1 sighter and 5 to count at each of 300 and 400 yards.

Shooting starts on Friday at 11.30am and on Saturday and Sunday at 9.30 am and continues until completed.

Prizes:

There will be a prize for each aggregate, open to all, and the much sought after Volunteer Cup for the highest scoring competitor in the Minié competition who is also a member of a Nottinghamshire Rifle Association affiliated club.

There is also the Mott Trophy to compete for, in memory of Mike Mott who created the weekend of competition and was an unwavering supporter. It will be awarded to the top scoring competitor who is not eligible to win the Volunteer Cup (not a member of a Notts RA affiliated club).
