8pm to 9pm Buffet and networking (Club representatives have the opportunity to mingle

and meet like-minded people from other Clubs in order to discuss shooting

matters of interest).

9pm to 9.15pm	Club members reflect on matters raised during the networking session and prepare to give a summary of their thoughts.
9.15pm to 9.45pm	Taking into consideration matters discussed during the networking session, a representative of each Club takes a couple of minutes to provide feedback to the wider audience as to issues their Club sees as being fundamental to the development of shooting in their Club and the County in the short and medium term.
9.45pm	Formal event closes with remarks from the Notts RA Chairman Dick Rosling and Notts RA host, Michael Hunting.
9.45pm to 10.30pm	Informal socialising.
